



Write each tricky word on a separate piece of paper. Then stick or hang them around the home. When they see a tricky word ask the child to try to read it (e.g. 'go'). <p>Topic</p>	<p>Think of a dinosaur and describe it to a member of your family. They have to guess which dinosaur you are. Remember to use adjectives to describe your dinosaur.</p> 	<p>Science Experiment</p> <p>Can you find 5 things that float and 5 things that sink?</p> <p>Talk about what float and sinks means. Ask the children to predict whether it will float or sink first.</p>	<p>Use your toys to tell a story. Once the story has finished, ask questions about the story, or questions that will extend the story. What happens to (character)? What did they do? Where did they go? What happened next?</p> 		

	<p>E.g. 'I am big. I have a long neck and a long tail.' 'I like to eat leaves in the trees.' What am I?</p>
