In class we were learning about different types of data. Remember creating our own pictograms?

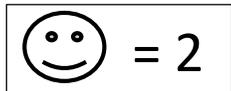

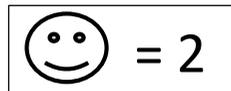

**Collecting and presenting data.**

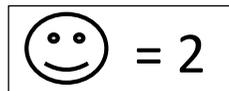
Now it's your turn to collect some data!
