You could even help out in the kitchen like the children in the first video.</p> <p>RE: We will begin to learn about Islam, this week we’re learning about the Muslim beliefs linked to caring for the world. We’ll begin building our castles next week. For this week we’re going to draw and colour our own pictures of castles inspired by a piece of art by Paul Klee. Writing	<p>Monday is Star Wars day so I feel compelled to include some work on Star Wars. When you’re not doing your other home learning tasks you could watch one of the Star Wars films to help you get ideas for some Star Wars based writing. Here are some suggestions for you:</p> <p>Write your own Star Wars story. Write a film review of one of the Star Wars films. Rewrite your favourite part as a play, you could even perform with your family. Write a summary of your favourite Star Wars film and explain why it is your favourite. We will continue to focus some writing on the book *The Tiny Seed* by Eric Carle. Please use this video of the book being read <https://youtu.be/3mtp0VHJuP4> for this week I would like you to complete one writing activity based on the story: Watch the video up to 1 minute 36 seconds, this is up to when the bird eats one of the seeds. So far five seeds have been lost, I want you to think about the places where the seeds have been lost, the sun and sky, the mountains, the ocean, the desert or the grass. The story doesn't tell us much about any of these places, I would like you to pick one of these places and write a detailed description about what your chosen place. Use your senses to describe the place, what can you see, hear, smell, touch and taste. It may help to draw a picture of the place before you write about it.
