





Create stepping stones 0-20. Encourage children to say the number out loud as they land on each stepping stone.




**Pirate Addition**

Can you think of and solve your own Pirate number stories?


For example... There were 4 gold coins. The pirate found 2 more gold coins. How many gold coins are there altogether?

| <p><b>Topic</b></p>         | <p><b>Underpants Designers</b><br/>Create a new pair of underpants for the pirates. You could use paint, felt tips, pencils or collage materials.</p>  | <p><b>Materials Hunt</b><br/>Think about the different materials that are used to make underpants. Why don't we make them with other materials (E.g. paper, wood, bricks, foil)?</p> <p>Can you go on hunt around your home and find different materials?</p>  | <p><b>Treasure Chest Craft</b><br/>Using a cardboard box or egg box, make your own treasure chest.</p>  | <p><b>Construction</b><br/>Make a pirate ship using Lego, Duplo or wooden bricks. Then using paper, create a flag to stick onto your pirate ship.</p>  | <p><b>Pirate Songs</b><br/>Learn the words and join in with different pirate songs, sung to a familiar tune!<br/>See Attached.</p>  |
