These will be sent out next week and will be arriving by post.

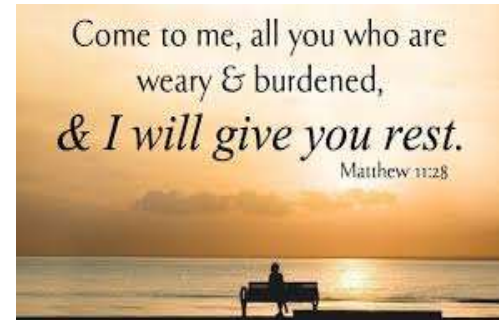
Staff Training Day - Wednesday 22nd July 2020
