Please ensure your child has a PE t-shirt, shorts and plimsoles in a named drawstring bag at school; this will remain on their peg so that your child can change themselves ready for the lesson. Please also ensure earrings are removed, for these days, and long hair must be tied back.

During the colder months, your child can wear black/navy sports trousers and jumpers. Please ensure all clothing is NAMED and that your child practises dressing themselves to support their independence, in particular, putting on shoes and tights.





At school, we enjoy sharing lots of stories with the children. We also encourage them to look at and engage with picture books independently and with friends. This develops their love of reading. The children will now bring home a library

book each week and we encourage you to share this with them and talk through it, reading it to them. As the term progresses your children will also be bringing home a class reading book that they have used during the week. This is theirs to keep and they will be able to read and share it with you.
