Term 2

This term our topic has been 'Great Explorers'. The children have explored the lives and achievements of Christopher Columbus, Matthew Henson and Neil Armstrong. They asked questions about Neil Armstrong and researched the answers to find out he was the first man to walk on the moon, they even made him a rocket. The children ordered the events of Christopher Columbus' voyage and drew out the boat he travelled in.

The children have enjoyed learning actions and creating a story map for 'The Way Back Home'. We designed our own planet for the boy to land on and used adjectives to describe it. The children then wrote their own imaginative stories.

We have had fun exploring addition and subtraction, the children have worked hard to find fact families and know their number bonds to 10. We have used different methods to add and subtract including partwhole models, tens frames, bead strings and number lines.
