## <u>Homework</u>

Homework is set weekly and is focused on our maths and phonics learning. Homework is sent home on a Friday and should be completed and returned to school by Wednesday the following week. Homework will be checked and stamped in school. If children are regularly completing their homework to a high standard to go above and beyond with a piece of homework, they may receive a Homework Certificate to celebrate their hard work!

### <u>P.E.</u>

In P.E. this term, the children in Class 2 have been learning Multi-skills. They have been learning new skills including how to move around in different directions and team strategy games.

Children are expected to have their P.E. kit in school for every P.E. lesson. P.E. kit must consist of a white or house coloured t-shirt, black or blue leggings/tracksuit bottoms/shorts and trainers or plimsols. It is important that the children have the correct P.E. kit so they are able to take part in P.E. lessons safely and effectively.



### Reading Classes R, 1 and 2

The children bring home two books each week, to read at home:


- A Success for All Phonics reading scheme book
- PRACTICE MAKES PROGRESS.
- A 'reading for pleasure' book

Books will go home every Friday and need to be returned with the purple reading record every Wednesday.

## The purple reading record book MUST be signed by an adult who has read with the child each week.

The children work hard in their phonics reading sessions using their reading scheme book each week. Please read for 5 – 10 minutes daily to help your child practise their reading skills. Please record this in the purple book every time you read at home.

The children should be reading for 5 – 10 minutes every day to ensure they are getting the practice they need to develop their reading skills further.
