Term 2 2023

This term our topic has been 'Great Explorers'. The children have explored the lives and achievements of Christopher Columbus, Matthew Henson and Neil Armstrong. They asked questions about Neil Armstrong, discovered he was the first man to walk on the moon, and made rockets. The children ordered the events of Christopher Columbus' voyage and thought carefully about objects from the past compared to now.

The children have enjoyed learning how to write instructions. We learnt that verbs are 'doing' words and help us to understand how to make things. The children worked in pairs to follow the instructions for making a 'delicious honey sandwich'. They then wrote their own instructions following the sequence we had learnt.

We have had fun exploring addition and subtraction, the children have worked hard to find fact families and know their number bonds to 10. We have used different methods to add and subtract including partwhole models, tens frames, beads and number lines.

Please let me know if there are any problems with providing a P.E. kit.


This term the children have been learning Gymnastics and been learning different rolls and floor work, they have also using the equipment to travel in a variety of ways.
