This term, we have travelled back in time to the Shang dynasty era, in Topic, learning about what life was like and examining ancient artefacts. We drew our very own (impressive) Chinese Dragons, painted beautiful cherry blossom pictures and even created our own oracle bones from clay, following the divination ceremony of the Shang kings, to predict the future. In Science, we have explored our local environment. We have learnt the names of some plants and trees and sorted them looking closely at their characteristics. We have sorted animals into their group types: reptiles, amphibians, mammals, fish and birds. We have recognised positive and negative changes to the local environment. In Design and Technology, the children enjoyed building structures using marshmallows and cocktail sticks. Reading

Classes 3 – 6



The children in Key Stage 2 are all given a reading book that is matched to their Accelerated Reader level. We assess this termly and adjust the choice of books accordingly. As the books are different lengths the children can return them when they are finished and select a new book to take home. Alongside their reading book they have a purple reading record that is for you to record everytime your child reads at home.

The children should be reading for 5 – 10 minutes every day to ensure they are getting the practice they need to develop their reading skills further.
