Homework

Homework is set weekly and is focused on our maths and phonics learning. Homework is sent home on a Friday and should be completed and returned to school by Wednesday the following week.

Homework will be checked and stamped in school. If children are regularly completing their homework to a high standard to go above and beyond with a piece of homework, they may receive a Homework Certificate to celebrate their hard work!





In PE this term, the children in Class 2 have been learning Multi-skills. They have been learning new skills including how to move

around in different directions and team strategy games.

Children are expected to have their PE kit in school for every PE lesson. PE kit must consist of a white or house coloured t-shirt, black or blue leggings/tracksuit bottoms/shorts and trainers or plimsols. Earrings must be removed.

It is important that the children have the correct PE kit so they are able to take part in PE lessons safely and effectively.



Reading

The children bring home a reading for pleasure book each week, to read at home.

Books will go home every Friday and need to be returned with the purple reading record every **Wednesday**.

Please ensure you return the books we send home as these are from the reading corner in our classroom and we

love having a good variety of books to read in school!



The children will receive a raffle ticket every time they bring their **signed** purple reading record to school by Wednesday. These raffle tickets give the children a chance to win a reading themed prize at the end of each term!
