Learning Interventions

We are always looking to support your child in their learning, so at any point during the year we may offer them an opportunity to work in a small group or 1:1 to enhance their learning. These sessions will take place during the school day.

Term 1 & 2 Learning

<u>Maths</u> We will be exploring number, which includes place value – number recognition, counting, greater/smaller. These will include a range of fluency questions in addition to questions that involve reasoning and problem solving skills and completed within child-led play activities (continuous provision).

<u>Literacy</u> We are going to revise and extend our phonic knowledge and writing abilities, read a wonderful range of texts (including traditional tales and Elmer stories related to our weather topic) and begin to participate in our 'Roots programme'.

<u>Science</u> T1 - 'Seasonal Changes' - This will link closely with our topic. T2 - 'Animals including Humans' primarily focussing on animals, their characteristics, diets and habitats.

<u>Topic/Art</u> T1 - 'Wonder Weather' - Children will explore what weather we have in the UK and other parts of the world; the affects they have on nature and human lives. T2 - 'Exciting Explorers' Children will discover the amazing journeys of Christopher Columbus and Neil Armstrong; how their discoveries have impacted life today.

<u>RE</u> 'Christianity' - We will continue to explore what Christians believe and why.

PE The children will be learning football skills.

french We will begin to learn french colours.

<u>Music</u> We are going to create music that represents different weather and listen to Vivaldi - 'The Four Seasons'. In Term 2, we are going to create 'music from out of Space' and listen to Saint-Saens - 'Carnival of the Animals'.

Accelerated Reader:

We will be encouraging your children to work through their Accelerated Reading levels. It is so important for the children to read as much as possible; this helps to expand their vocabulary and reading and writing ability, in addition to widen their understanding of the world around them. We hope their enjoyment for reading continues/improves in the future.
