

<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>English</u></b></p> <p>This term we will be exploring <i>The Tale of Chicken Little</i>, <i>Animal Poems</i> and the nonfiction text <i>Extreme Earth</i>.</p> <p>We will be learning actions to help us retell the story through drama and story maps. Once we have learnt and can retell the story, we will begin making changes to the story to create our own versions.</p> <p>We will also be carrying out lots of work using our phonics sounds. This will enable us to spell words correctly and then begin to build sentences using simple punctuation.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>PE</u></b></p> <p>Children will focus on developing their fundamental movement skills, including running, jumping, hopping, throwing, and catching. They will also begin to build their fitness through activities that develop strength, stamina, and agility, helping them improve coordination and confidence.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>MUSIC</u></b></p> <p>Children will be chanting different call and response sound patterns and progress to creating their own call and response patterns using untuned percussion instruments. They will practise rhythm and pulse, building a strong sense of musical communication.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>MATHS</u></b></p> <p>This term we will be covering Place Value and Addition and Subtraction.</p> <p>Within our Place Value unit, we will be recognising tens and ones to help us partition numbers up to 100, as well as writing numbers to 100 in both words and digits. We will be comparing, ordering and estimating numbers, in addition to counting in 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s.</p> <p>Within our Addition and Subtraction unit, we will be learning about fact families, to add and subtract 1s, to add by making 10 and adding three 1-digit numbers.</p>

Class 2 will compare features in the North and South Poles and Kenya as well as in the local area and learn the four compass points and the names and location of the seven continents</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>ART &amp; DESIGN</u></b></p> <p>This term Otters will be learning about Craft and Design. The children will explore maps and create their own using different means and representation. Otters will also learn and apply the steps of the felt-making process.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>COMPUTING</u></b></p> <p>This term we will be learning about computing systems and networks. We will be identifying the different parts of a computer as well as understanding its role.
