Dear Parents/Carers,

We are very pleased to announce that our children will be continuing with our Forest School sessions throughout this academic year. The sessions will be run by our Forest School specialist, Ms. Liz Cooke and will be held in our Forest School within the school grounds.

Forest School is an inspiring process, a specialised approach to outdoor learning that aims to develop confidence and self-esteem through hands-on learning in the outside environment.

To enable the children to be comfortable, dry and warm during these sessions we ask that they are provided with Forest School clothing to wear on their allocated days. This should include a **long-sleeved t-shirt or top** as well as **long trousers or leggings** as well as a **coat or jacket**. As the children will be completing a variety of activities outside, **old clothes** would be very appropriate! As well as clothes, we would be grateful if the children could also bring an **old pair of trainers or wellies** for their session.

Forest School sessions will run throughout the year and as the weather will become cooler in the future months it is essential that the children are warm and that they also have dry clothes to change back in to after their session, if needed.

If your child is attending the **afternoon session** they should bring their Forest School clothes with them in a bag ready to get changed into before lunch.
