Physical Development

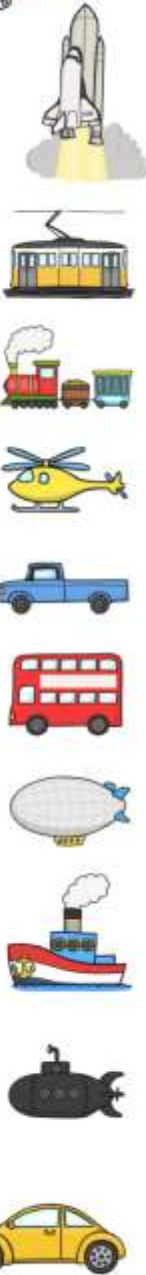
In PE this term, children will develop fundamental ball skills such as; rolling and receiving the ball, throwing to a target, bouncing and catching and dribbling the ball. Children will also be able to develop their fine motor and gross motor skills through a range of game play using a variety of equipment.

Understanding the World

The children will be introduced to a new member of the class. His name is 'Barnaby Bear'. Barnaby Bear likes to travel and is excited to explore the world with us this term.

The children will know what town they live in and what their school is called. They will explore Google Earth and zoom in on our local area. Barnaby Bear will then travel to different landmarks within the UK.

Later in the term, we will explore global landscapes and compare them to our own.



Communication and Language and Literacy

This term, we will be using some well-loved stories with an 'Around the World' theme to develop our reading and writing. These stories will include; Whatever Next, The Naughty Bus, Handa's Surprise and The Snail and the Whale. We will also use simple information books to support our understanding and to find out more about hot and cold places.

In our reading, we will learn to recognise and name these digraphs and trigraphs: or (corn), ur (purple), ow (cow), oi (boil), ear (clear).



Mathematics

In Maths, children will practise subitising within 6. They will also focus on representations of numbers using their fingers and the 10-frames.

Later in the term, the children will be introduced to the rekenreks, where they will learn to represent familiar numbers,

Expressive Arts and Design

We will start our new topic by creating our own class passports. We will create flags from different countries around the world and our outdoor role play area will transform into a Travel Agents. We will also explore paint and print and use this to inspire our creative work in the classroom. We will learn songs and rhymes linked to our topic theme.
