In English this term, the children will be reading a range of model texts and using them as a guide to produce their own writing.

The children will be writing a narrative, a poem and a non-chronological report.

- To write for a range of purposes and audiences.
- To use and understand grammatical terminology accurately and appropriately in discussing my writing and reading.
- To use expanded noun phrases for effect in my independent writing.
- To use the full range of punctuation taught at key stage 2.

PE

Our PE is taught on a Tuesday and Thursday afternoon. This term, we will be practising our football and tag rugby skills.

- Dribble with control under pressure
- Communicate with team mates
- Throw and catch
- Change direction when running
- To apply rules, skills and principles to play in a tournament.

MUSIC

This term, the children will explore baroque and will:

- Understand the importance of Monteverdi in the history of opera.
- Read and play a canon from staff notation.
- Compose and perform with others.

MATHS

This term in Mathematics, the children will be learning about shape and position and direction. By the end of the units, they will be able to:

Shape:

- To measure and classify angles.
- To calculate angles.

Position and Direction

- To read and plot points in four quadrants.
- To solve problems with coordinates.
- To translate shapes.
- To reflect shapes.

SCIENCE

Our topic this term is 'Animals including Humans'. We will be exploring these enquiry questions and taking part in a range of practical investigations:

- What is the purpose of the circulatory system?
- Why is blood so important?
- How does exercise affect our circulatory system?
- How are nutrients and water transported within animals, including humans?
- How do diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle impact our bodies?

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Kingdom of God

What kind of king is Jesus? This investigation question will allow the children to learn and reflect on the acts and teachings of Jesus and think why he is known as a 'king'. They will make connections with the bible and the lives lived today. They will explore the Christian beliefs respectfully as well as reflect on their own theories, beliefs and values. They will shape their own opinions and have the opportunity to discuss their thoughts.

They will then progress and explore symbolism and its importance to Christians.

GEOGRAPHY

In topic this term, we will be learning about carrying out a fieldwork enquiry. By the end of the unit, the children will be able to:

- Give examples of issues in the local area
- Identify questions to be asked to find the relevant data
- Design an accurate data collection template
- Identify areas along a route that are best for data collection
- Collect data at points located on an OS map
- Identify any outcomes from data collected
- Describe the enquiry process

ART AND DESIGN

Our topic this term is sculpture and 3D: Making Memories. Throughout the term, the children will be:

- Analysing how art can explore the concept of self.
- Exploring sculptural techniques.
- Using creative experience to develop ideas and plan a sculpture,
- Problem solving, evaluating and refining artwork to achieve a chosen outcome.

COMPUTING

Our unit this term explores the concept of data. The children will be exploring what data is and how it is used. They will be using a variety of programmes to problem solve and present their findings.

- To recognise that data can become corrupted within a network.

LANGUAGES

In my French house is our topic this term and the children will learn:

- To describe houses in French.
- To write a description of a house in French.
- To use prepositions to describe the position of items in the bedroom.
- To write a letter describing my home.

PSHE

In PSHE this term, we will be learning about how to build and maintain positive, healthy relationships. The children will:

- Understand how to keep their mental health happy.
- Identify reasons why people grieve.
- Recognise when someone is taking power/control.
- Learn how to keep themselves safe online.
