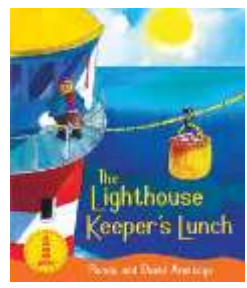

Personal, Social and Emotional Development.

Transition to Year 1. This term we will continue our work on preparing the children for the move into Year One. The children will be able to visit the Year One classroom and spend time becoming familiar with their new environment ready for September.

In PSHE and our circle time sessions, we will talk about our bodies and growing up.



Understanding the World

First, we will explore different things we might see and do at the seaside. Then, we will compare photos of seaside holidays, now and in the past. Finally, we will learn about different creatures that live under the sea.

Physical Development

We will be using the movements of different sea creatures in our dance and drama work this term. Our P.E. lessons will be outside, where we will participate in running, team games and practise events ready for Sports Day. We will also learn about safety in the sun.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be learning songs and rhymes with a seaside theme. The children will create 3D sea creatures. We will explore the Summer and use this to inspire our creative work in the classroom. We will create lighthouses using recycled modelling materials.

Communication and Language and Literacy

The children will be reading and writing about the seaside. We will make simple sentences, writing about what we have discovered. We will also be using some well-loved stories with a sea theme to develop our reading and writing. These stories will include, The Lighthouse Keepers Lunch, Tiddler and Commotion in the Ocean.

We will continue to develop the children's reading skills in small groups with adult support. In these groups, children will read the shared reader that is matched to their reading ability.

Mathematics

We will learn to recognise the pattern of the counting system when beginning to count beyond 20.

We will also investigate 'parts' and 'wholes', exploring the composition of numbers to 10.
