1 INTRODUCTION:

2 Aims and Objectives for St Mary's School.

- Provide a broad and balanced curriculum where each child will achieve academically, working to the best of their ability.
- Encourage each child to discover new interests and to persevere when learning is difficult.

This publication is a means of showing how we are pursuing these aims.

3 Categories of Information Published

The publication scheme guides you to information which we currently publish (or have recently published) or which we will publish in the future. This is split into categories of information known as "classes." These are contained in section 6 of this scheme.

The classes of information that we undertake to make available are organised into four broad topic areas:

School Prospectus – Information published in the school prospectus.

Governors' Documents – Information published in the School Profile and in other governing body documents.

Pupils & Curriculum: - Information about policies that relate to pupils and the school curriculum.
