







Share your ideas with a grown up. Encourage the children to answer in full sentences.</p> <p>E.g. Farmer Duck picked the apples.</p>  <p>Now have a go at writing a list of the jobs Farmer Duck does e.g. Dig, wash, pick</p>	<p>Watch this video and practice reading the Tricky Words.</p>  <p><a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TvMyssfAUx0">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TvMyssfAUx0</a></p>	<p>Practise your handwriting, using pens, pencils, crayons, paintbrushes, felt tips or whatever you can lay your hands on! Show your grown-ups how we do our cursive letters at school. Remember to think carefully and use lead ins and lead outs. You could practise writing 2 sounds each day.</p> 









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Maths	<p><b>Spot the mistake</b> Make deliberate mistakes whilst counting up and down from 0 -20 (a puppet/teddy is great for this).</p> <p>Ask the children to listen carefully and stop you if they hear a mistake.</p> 	<p>Find 5 toys and put them in height order.</p> <p>Encourage children to use words to compare the height e.g. taller than and shorter than. Toys could be ordered from shortest to tallest and tallest to shortest.</p> 	<p>How many steps?</p> <p>How many steps is it from your bedroom to the bathroom?</p> <p>How many steps is it from your bedroom to the kitchen?</p> <p>Can you come up with some more ideas?</p> 	<p>Can you make a number line? It can be as long as you like! Then use a toy vehicle and a homemade ramp to measure how far your vehicle can travel. What number does your vehicle stop on? What is one more or one less than that number?</p> 	<p>Can you practise adding with your toys?</p> <p>For example 5 dinosaurs add 2 dinosaurs? How many are altogether?</p>
Afternoon Activity	<p>Can you research different ducks? Do all ducks look the same? Where do ducks live?</p> 	<p>This week we are finding out about different animals that live on the farm.</p> <p>Play what am I?</p>	<p>Create your own farm animal stick puppets.</p> 	<p>Can you use an old box to make a puppet theatre?</p> <p>You could then use your farm animal stick puppets to retell the story of Farmer Duck.</p> <p>Could you make up a new story using your</p>	<p><b>RE</b></p> <p><b>Why are Christians given palm crosses?</b></p> <p>Tom and Tessa have got a special cross, it is called a Palm Cross.
