English	This week we will be looking at the story The Way Back Home and using it as a stimulus for writing. Use this video to listen to and read along with the story https://youtu.be/y5yYd6lssGg						
	Focus on the page when the boy and the alien meet for the first time and the page just before this. Role play the boy and alien feeling scared just before they meet because of the strange sounds and darkness. Then role play them meeting for the first time. Think about how they feel in this part of the story. Use you facial expressions to show their different feelings.	Focus on the page after the boy and the alien meet for the first time when they are making plans about how to get home. I want you to make up your own, different ending for the story. How do you think the boy and the alien will fix their machines and get home?	By now you should know the story quite well. If you need reminding watch the video again. Today I would like you to retell the story using pictures and as few words as possible. We call this a story map. Make the first half of the story map. Use the template and example to help.	Today you need to finish your story map. You should have made the first half in the previous lesson. Watch the video if you need to remind yourself of the story. Then use the template and example to help you finish your story map.	Now you know the story really well and you have made a story map to retell the story. Today I want you to rewrite the story in your own words. It is important you don't watch the video, instead write the story from memory using your story map to help you remember.
