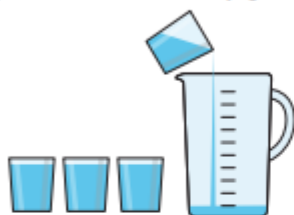


Tuesday: Maths
