

## Tricky Words - Magic Camera Game



Using the word bank below, write each tricky word on a separate piece of paper or you can just add the new words to your collection if you've had a go at this game previously. When the words have been written down, stick them in different places around your home.

Remember when your child sees a tricky word, it cannot be sounded out, it must be recognised as a whole word. Children read the tricky word and take a 'photo' of it, using a pretend camera.

Tricky Word Bank: I, to, go, no, the, he, she, we, me, be, you, all, are, her, was, they, my
