#### **Contact Tracing Over Half Term**

The DfE has asked schools to continue with contact tracing over half term, similar to the arrangements over Easter. School leaders are required to assist with NHS tracking and tracing for 6 days after the end of term – until and including Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> June. Please note the following:

- 1. Staff and parents/carers of pupils need to inform the school of a positive case where they developed symptoms within 48 hours of being at school.
- 2. Staff and parents/carers of pupils who were asymptomatic, but tested positive within 48 hours of last being in school, also need to let the school know.
- The school should assist in identifying close contacts and advising self-3. isolation, as the individual may have been infectious whilst in their education setting.
- Where pupils or staff test positive for coronavirus (COVID-19) during the holidays, having developed symptoms more than 48 hours since being at school, schools are not required to take any action. Staff and parents/carers should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.

To notify me during the holiday please email office@stmarysprimary.net. This is the only account which is guaranteed to be monitored during the relevant time. If I am notified of a positive result, as per the above criteria, the relevant school children and staff member contacts will be informed by email and text sent from the Parentmail system. Do please, of course, keep us updated in the new term with any Covidrelated information which you are not required to advise us of during the holiday. Thank you.



#### Free School Meals – Did you know ...?

Your child might be able to have free school meals if you get any of the following:

• Universal Credit - your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance

• Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999

• The guaranteed element of Pension Credit

• Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)

• Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit.

### Rapid Coronavirus (COVID-19) testing

Household members of primary age children are eligible to access regular, rapid coronavirus (COVID-19) testing. Tests are fast, easy and free. You can order home test kits online. Order rapid lateral flow home test kits or you can collect from a home test kit collection point. Find your nearest home test kit collection point. Please note that these tests are for adults within the family, not the children.

#### Coronavirus Symptoms

Children or staff with any of the three symptoms of Covid:

- a new continuous cough
- a high temperature
- a loss or change to your sense of taste or smell
