




<p>Afternoon Activity</p>	<p>Watch the story 'Lost and Found' by Oliver Jeffers</p>  <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=xNgh3Q58Qol</p>	<p>Penguins live near the South Pole. The little boy needs to do some research to find out where it is. Do you know where it is? Look on the globe or an atlas or on the internet. Is it near or far away from where you live? How do you think you could travel there?</p>	<p>Ice Investigators! Put some ice cubes into a tray. Encourage children to explore what happens as the ice melts. What could make the ice melt faster?</p>	<p>Can you make a boat for one of your toys? Make sure it is big enough for them to fit in. You could use a box and decorate it. What could you make for the oars?</p> 	<p>Use different materials to make your own penguin model. You can choose how big or small it is. To make your penguin you could use cardboard, paint, playdough, collage materials etc.</p> 







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	<p>What characters did we meet in the story? Why was the penguin sad? Who helped the penguin? Where did the little boy take the penguin? How did they get there?
