English	This week our literacy lessons will focus on our class book 'The Robot and The Bluebird'. Use this video link to listen to the story and read along https://youtu.be/RwoZ5ZVpflU				
	Make a prediction. Before reading or listening to the story look at the cover. Think about the clues you can see that tell you about the story. Use the main picture and the title to make a prediction about the story. What will the story be about?	List what you know about the main character. Look at the first page and focus on the blue robot in the top right. Compare this robot to the others and think about how he is the same and different. List down all of the ideas you can think of.	Write thought and speech bubbles. Look at the next page in the story where the robots are trying to fix the main character. What is each character doing? What are their jobs? What are they thinking and saying? Write some speech and thought bubbles to answer these questions.	List key events. Continue reading or listening to the story up until the pages where the robot is sitting on top of the scrapheap looking up at the sky. List the events that the robot has gone through to get him to this point.	Plan a diary entry. Using your work from the previous lesson think about what the robot would write in his diary. Use your list from the previous lesson to help plan the events you will include in your diary.
