English	Write a diary entry. Using your work from the previous lesson, write a diary entry as the robot. Use events from the story to help write your diary entry up to the point where the robot is sitting on top of the scrapheap looking up at the sky.	Write a character description. Continue reading or listening to the story up until the pages where we first meet the Bluebird. Stop at the line 'You can sleep there if you like.' Use the information on this page to write a short description of what you learn about the Robot and the Bluebird. Hang these up in the outdoor area so you can monitor them and note visitors in a bird spotter diary.	Write a set of instructions. Write up the recipe for making the cakes using the proper features, e.g. lists of ingredients and equipment and staged instructions, numbered so that they are easy to follow.	Write advice to the robot. Continue reading or listening to the story up until the pages where the robot is climbing the mountains. Stop at the line 'and his joints groaned with every step.' Write advice for the robot, should he keep going and risk damage or stop and give up to save himself?
