Collective Worship 2021-22 - Term 1

Worship in schools should be **"inclusive, invitational and inspiring"** according to the Church of England's new guidance for collective worship.

The new guidance describes Collective Worship as the **"unique heartbeat of a Church school"** which is offered as part of a wider opportunity for pupils and adults to encounter faith.
